It is our pleasure to invite you to discover two choral traditions at the crossroads of Europe and Asia.

We have designed the Study Tour as a modular system where you can choose between three possibilities and either visit one or both countries. The first and last days are always planned as travel days.

Option 1: Study tour to Georgia | 14-20/9/2024

Option 2: Study tour to Armenia | 20-26/9/2024

Option 3: Study tour to both countries (Georgia and Armenia) | 14-26/9/2024
(with the option of extending the stay, arriving earlier or leaving later)

DETAILED PROGRAMME OF THE STUDY TOURS

Study tour to Georgia | 14-20/09/2024 (subject to changes)



Saturday, 14/09/2024

All those wishing to attend our Study Tour in Georgia should plan to arrive on Saturday 14th September. On this day visitors will have time to discover Tbilisi and meet and greet other participants at a dinner organized by our hosts.

Sunday, 15/09/2024

Visit the city of Rustavi. A short concert of Rustavi folk ensemble "Me Rustveli" will take place in the Ethnographic Museum of the city, located near the historical fortress. Visitors will also meet the Mayor of the city and listen to the Grand Concert of the "Tutarchela Youth Choir" in Rustavi Municipal Theater.

Monday, 16/09/2024

We will start the day with a tour of the capital city – Tbilisi. We will also visit State Folklore Centre (possibly meet the Georgian Minister of Culture), followed by a visit to the State ensemble "Basiani" and Trinity Cathedral / State Chamber Choir.

Tuesday, 17/09/2024

Excursion to the City of Gori and Uplistsikhe – the ancient cave city (the price of the museum ticket is 7.5 Euros, the payment must be made individually before entering the museum). After visiting the tangible cultural heritage sites, we will learn about the intangible heritage, which will be presented by "Gori women Choir" and "Gori Girls' Choir".

Wednesday, 18/09/2024

We will visit historical monuments of Mtskheta, the ancient capital of Georgia. In the afternoon, we will meet the representatives of the Choral Society of Georgia and the "Student Choir of Tbilisi State Conservatoire".

Thursday, 19/09/2024

Meeting the State Chorus Capella of Georgia and Abkhazia and choral composers of Georgia. We will also learn about the work of the boys' Choir "Mdzlevari".

Friday, 20/09/2024

The first part of the Study Tour ends here. Full of impressions, you will return home, or perhaps you will decide to extend your stay and join us for the second part, which will lead us on a journey of discovery of the choral traditions of Armenia. You can buy a bus or taxi ticket from Tbilisi to Yerevan online (contacts are [HERE](#)) or pay directly after the trip and it costs around 40-45€. The Armenian team will greet you at the bus station.

Study tour to Armenia | 20-26/09/2024 (subject to changes)



Saturday, 20/09/2024

All those wishing to attend only a Study Tour to Armenia should plan to arrive on Saturday, September 20. On this day you will have time to discover vivid Yerevan, a city that is older than ancient Rome.

Sunday, 21/09/2024

We are very excited to start our Study Tour to Armenia on a very special day, Armenia Independence Day, and we will make it a day to remember. We will have short sessions on the history of Armenian choral singing, attend a rehearsal of the Yerevan Chamber Choir, and then visit the Matenadaran - center of Armenian and world written heritage, one of the main symbols of Armenia. We will learn about the old Armenian music system, enjoy a small concert in the museum and in the evening we will have a welcoming dinner and enjoy delicious Armenian cuisine.

Monday, 22/09/2024

We will visit the Church of Saint Gregory the Illuminator and enjoy the Armenian liturgy, as liturgical music is the basis of Armenian choral singing. This will be followed by a visit to the choral festival

dedicated to the 155th anniversary of Comitas, we will attend the repetition of the choir "Paros" for the disabled and the opera "Anoosh" by A. Tigranyan.

Tuesday, 23/09/2024

We will watch a film about children's choirs that have succeeded not only in Armenia, but also internationally. This will be followed by a panel discussion with local conductors and choirs, a visit to a rehearsal of the "Armenian State Academic Choir" and enjoying a concert by the "Song and dance ensemble after Tatul Altunyan".

Wednesday, 24/09/2024

We will start the day with a trip to the Echmiatsin - Armenia's spiritual center and the first Christian church, followed by a meeting at Gevorgyan Seminary, where you will enjoy a short performance by the seminary's men's choir. We will then visit the Armenian Cognac Factory where we will have a tour and tasting.

Thursday, 25/09/2024

On a tour from Yerevan to the historical monuments of Khor Virap, Garni - the only Hellenistic temple in Armenia - and Geghard, we will learn about Armenia's rich history. Upon our return, we will have some free time to discover Yerevan and in the evening we will meet for a concert by the Armenian State Chamber Choir - "Miqeyan Choir" and the closing ceremony.

Friday, 26/09/2024

We have come to the end of our time together. We trust that this epic journey will leave you with many great memories and may inspire you for your future work. You can stay a few more days in the region and organize your own trip or ask us for advice.

ACCOMODATION

!! IMPORTANT: Accommodation is NOT included in the participation fees published below, so participants have to book their own hotel rooms !! The following is just a recommendation on the choice of the hotel.

Accommodation in Georgia

Our official "Study Tour" hotel in Georgia will be the [Hotel Irmeni](#), 1 Martkopi St., Tbilisi. The hotel Irmeni is offering participants the following rates:

- 1 night for 1 person - 50 eur
- 1 night for 2 people - 60 eur

These prices include breakfast.

These prices include a discount, which is only valid during the period of the Study Tour to Georgia and is only available to the participants.

If you would like to stay at [Hotel Irmeni](#), and you would like to profit from these special rates, **please write to the tutarchela2007@yahoo.com by 15 March 2024** indicating which rooms you would like to book and local organisers will make a reservation for you. If you want these special rates, you should not book a room online. Upon arrival, you will pay the cost individually at the hotel reception on site.

If you would like to stay in a cheaper hotel or hostel, you can also check other options.

Accommodation in Armenia

Our official "Study Tour" hotel in Armenia will be the [Ani Plaza Hotel](#), Sayat Nova 19, in the center of Yerevan. This is a highly qualified hotel in Yerevan. The hotel is offering participants special rates all for single rooms:

- Standard room: 88 EUR per room & night
- Junior Room: 95 EUR per room & night
- Panorama room: 130 EUR per room & night

(the amount is calculated at the current euro rate)

These prices include breakfast, the city tax and the use of a swimming pool.

These prices include a discount, which is valid during the period of the Study Tour to Armenia and is available only for the participants.

If you would like to stay at the Ani Plaza Hotel and you would like to profit from these special rates, **please book your rooms by sending an e-mail by March 15th 2024** with the

reservation promo code "**Study Tour to Armenia 48053**" to reservation@anihotel.com indicating which rooms you would like to book from which date to which date.

You can also book additional nights before/after our Study Tour for the same rates. You will have to pay the hotel directly, and the preferential rules are only valid until 15/03/2024! If you would like to stay in a cheaper hotel or hostel, you can also check other options.

Another good point about the hotel is that it is located very close to the main meeting hall of our event, so it is a great starting point for a walk through the streets of Yerevan to our meetings. For lunch we propose a branch of cafeteria chain "ArtLunch" very close to the main meeting room (Aleq Manoogian 5).

TRANSPORTATION FROM AIRPORT TO THE HOTEL

Tbilisi, Georgia: Transport from the airport to the hotel can be arranged by a local organizer. If you would like assistance in arranging an airport shuttle, please use the contact details below to let the local organizers know your arrival and departure times. The following conditions apply to transport costs:

If 1, 2 or 3 people arrive at the same time, a Hotel Irmeni shuttle will meet you at the airport and transfer you to the hotel (after prior reservation with the local organizer). Transport costs - 20 EUR for 1 transfer (it can be shared between 2-3 passengers). Other transport costs during the Study Tour are included in the participation fee.

Yerevan, Armenia: Transport from the airport to the hotel will be organized and covered by local organizers, so please let them know your final travel plans using the contact details below. The same will be arranged for those traveling from Georgia to Armenia. The local team will be waiting for you at the bus stop.

PARTICIPATION FEES

Participation fee for the Georgian part includes all meals (lunches, dinners, coffee breaks), local transfers, concerts, performances and participation in the different events. **It does NOT include accommodation (see above).**

*The participation fee for the Georgian part is calculated on the assumption that we do not receive local subsidies. However, if we are successful and will receive co-funding in 2024, the fee will be lower.

Participation fee for the Armenian part includes only 2 meals (1 common dinner and 1 common lunch), coffee breaks, concerts, performances, local transportations, sim cards, individual translators participation in the different events and excursions. **It does NOT include other meals and accommodation (see above).**

IMPORTANT: Below you will see the participation fees, where you will notice the difference in price, which mainly reflects the different organization of the meals (in Georgia, meals are part of the participation fee, in Armenia the participants will have to take care of their own meals, as mentioned there will be only one lunch and one dinner will be organized).

International Association of Armenian Culture,

depending on whether you attend only one part or both parts of the Study Tour.

Please note: If you are planning to attend both parts of the Study Tour to Georgia and Armenia, your participation fee is the sum of the two fees and you will receive two different invoices.
